

IDF Says It Destroyed 'Hezbollah Tunnel Route' Stretching 'Dozens of Meters'

The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) released footage on Wednesday, August 5, showing what it [described](#) as the “destruction of [Hezbollah] underground infrastructure, spanning dozens of meters” in southern Lebanon.

The footage shows a targeted attack on Srebbine, in the Bint Jbeil District.

“The underground route was used by the Hezbollah terror organization to advance and execute terror plots against our forces,” the IDF said.

Lebanon’s state-run National News Agency [reported](#) on August 2 that an Israeli drone dropped a bomb on a civilian vehicle that was traveling alongside an army vehicle in Srebbine, injuring two army personnel and several civilians, according to translation services.

The source released the footage on Wednesday, August 5. Storyful could not independently verify the date of recording. Additional attacks were reported in the area on August 2 by [Lebanese state-run news outlets](#).
